I hope you are well.

It's been another hardworking week at Newnham and the children continue to be happy and make progress. Next week the Year 6 children will be taking their SATs tests so the timetable will be slightly different as there will not be any assemblies. The tests are an opportunity for the children to show how much they have progressed in their time at the school and we wish them all of the best.

Walk to School Week - Our school is taking part in Walk to School Week (20th – 24th May). The nationwide event is organised by walking charity Living Streets and designed to help pupils experience first-hand the importance of walking to school.
