**Dear Parents & Carers** 

I hope you are well.

As I'm sure you are all aware we have a new government with a large majority. Many schools are having to cut staff, move money away from repairing school buildings and reduce funding for education resources. Secondary schools are struggling to recruit maths and science teachers and the majority of education authorities cannot fund their special needs requirements due to increasing numbers of children with special educational needs and disabilities. It is incredible that so many schools have managed to keep standards so high within these financial constraints. For your children's sake, I really hope that this new government can take positive action and change things for the better.

**School General Election** – As part of the school's commitment to British Values, the children have been looking at our democratic process this week and have conducted their own election. All of the main parties manifestos were shared and the children held a secret ballot on the same day as the general election. The results mirrored what happened nationally with Labour coming out on top, winning all twelve of the school's constituencies (each class). Thank you to Mr Mansi for sprucing up our ballot box, Mrs Mayo for providing us with signage and voting booths and to Ms Curtis for organising everything.

**Sports 4 Schools** – Thank you to everyone who participated and collected sponsorship. To date we have raised £3655. This is an incredible amount which will be used to support GB athletes and purchase sports equipment for our school
