#### Academic

We achieved an 'outstanding' Ofsted inspection.

<u>SATs results</u> – This table shows the percentage of children who gained the national standard in Year 6 compared to the national average. It also shows the percentage of children who achieved greater depth (a scaled score of over 110). These are fantastic results and the progress the Year 6 children have made while they have been at Newnham (both schools) is astounding.
